May 16th, 2019

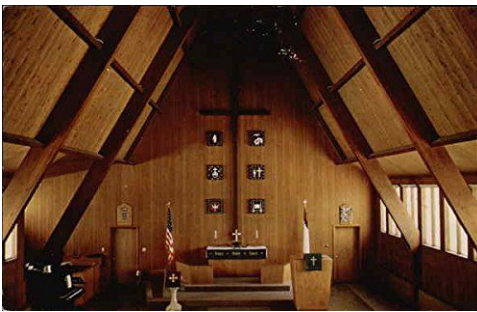
- We will meet at Bering Tea and Coffee at 9:00 a.m.

Seniors planning to attend vocational training or college: Don't forget to submit your CACHE scholarships. You can finish these anytime between now and June 30th. Make sure you upload all of your documents by June 30th or you won't get any funding! To make sure you have your final transcript, turn in a final transcript request form to Mrs. Perrigo BEFORE graduation. Then upload that transcript to your My-CACHE account. Other documents you may need to upload (BEFORE JUNE 30th!) include a picture of your diploma and your class schedule for the fall.
