

**REGISTRATION FORM
MIGRANT SWIM LESSONS – SPRING SESSION**

The Nome Public School Migrant Education Program is sponsoring a two-week swim lesson session for beginner/intermediate swimmers at the Nome Beltz Pool. There is no cost for these lessons. **Children must be currently migrant eligible.** Non-migrant eligible children may request to be placed on a wait list – if not enough migrant children register, empty slots will be filled off the wait list. Classes will be filled on a first come-first served. **There is a MAXIMUM of 10 students in each class.** If your child does not show up for the first lesson, they will lose their spot and it will be given to the next child on the wait list.

- **DATES:** Monday-Friday April 15th through April 26th
- **TIMES:** Session 1 – 4:30p-5p Session 2 – 5p-5:30p
- **AGES:** Children ages 6-8 in grades 1, 2 and 3
- **TRANSPORTATION:** Parents who do not have their own transportation should check below that they need cab vouchers. Vouchers can only be used for transportation from town to the pool and back.
- **WHAT TO BRING:** Swim suit and towel – children can change in the pool locker room.
- **OTHER INFORMATION:** A lifeguard will be on duty during swim lessons. A parent/guardian must accompany children to swim lessons and remain in the pool area.

Parents need to review the checklist on the back of this form to determine whether their child should register for the Beginner (Level 1/2) or Intermediate (Level 2/3) session. The swim instructor will conduct some skills tests on the first day of class – parents should be prepared for their child to move between sessions if needed – the swim instructor has final say over placement to ensure safety of all children in the class.

Skills Checklist

Please review the skills for Level 1/2 below and check off what your child can do. If your child cannot do the majority of these, he/she should register for Session 1 Beginning. If he/she can **consistently, comfortably** do the majority of these, he/she should register for Session 2 Intermediate.

- Enter and exit the water using a ladder, steps or the side of the pool
- Jump into the water
- Blow bubbles with their mouth AND nose
- Float without assistance on their back
- Roll from front to back or back to front
- Tread water using hands/arms
- Bob (Jump up and down in the pool with head submerging each time)
- Open eyes underwater
- Pick up an object on the bottom of the pool (in shallow water – 3 ft.)
- Alternate arms or legs in a swimming/kicking motion (attempts some type of swim stroke/kick)

The swim instructor will conduct skills tests on the first day of class to see if a student needs to move between sessions. Sessions are skills-based, not age-based.
